# THINGS TO REMEMBER

- You will need to participate in an inspection for both insurance claims and FEMA disaster assistance
- You can negotiate with your insurance carrier if you do not agree with their initial settlement offer
  - You can appeal if you are denied FEMA assistance
- Property or Renters insurance can cover lost and damaged items. The items covered will depend upon your policy coverage.

## ITEMS YOU MAY NEED WHEN APPLYING FOR ASSISTANCE

- Photos of damages to your home and belongings
  - **Receipts** for any emergency repairs or needs related to the damage
- Copies of your insurance policies
- Copies of *lease or rental agreement*, address (not PO Box), utility bill or deed showing homeownership
- Smartphone, laptop or tablet to participate in virtual inspections with FEMA, if requested







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
