



Baytown Area and Chambers County Disaster Recovery

Homeowners who have sustained damage from this storm and live in the Baytown and Chambers County area are asked to apply for help using a simple form that can be found here

Eligibility includes:

- The home must be your primary residence and you must have lived in the house prior to and during the storm.
- You must own the home. The home cannot have liens.
- The home must be local, within United Way of Greater Baytown Area & Chambers County's jurisdiction that includes Zip Codes: 77514, 77520, 77521, 77522, 77523, 77535, 77560, 77562, 77580, 77597, 77661, 77665.
- All eligibilities must be met. These include disability, elderly, and struggling financially and unable to pay for the repairs. Be prepared to provide proof of eligibility.
- All options for support will be considered "first-in" such as home owner's insurance, FEMA support, prior to initiating BACC DR efforts.
