Coordinated Entry (The Way Home CoC)

Coordinated Entry (CE) is the first step to accessing housing resources within The Way Home Continuum of Care (CoC). CE uses a standardized assessment to determine eligibility for housing programs, diversion services, and supportive services.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Individuals must be experiencing literal homelessness in Harris, Fort Bend, or Montgomery Counties. (Must be literally without housing living on the streets.)
- Assessment must be completed with a participating homeless service provider.

What Coordinated Entry Does:

- Coordinates intake, assessments, and prioritization across partner agencies.
- Helps determine appropriate housing and income interventions if available.
- Provides referrals to programs within The Way Home CoC.

Important Notes:

- Housing and services are not guaranteed.
- Availability depends on openings within partner programs.
