



#### Flood Watch



- A Flood Watch is in effect for south-central and southeast Texas from Wednesday morning through evening.
- Excessive rainfall may cause flooding of rivers, creeks, and low-lying areas.
- Monitor for possible flood warnings and be prepared to take action if you live in flood-prone areas.

#### OVERVIEW

- There will remain a high rainfall potential across the area through the remainder of the week and into the weekend.
- Heavy rain, along with the potential for flooding, remains a concern, especially for locations near the coast.
- There is a Moderate Risk (level 3 of 4) of Excessive Rainfall for portions of Chambers, Galveston and Liberty Counties today.

#### RAINFALL TOTALS

 Additional rainfall totals of 2-6" are possible through the end of the week, with the higher rain totals situated to the south of the I-10 corridor. Locally higher amounts are possible.

#### **IMPACTS & ACTIONS**

- Minor urban and small stream flooding
- If still dealing with debris from Beryl, please keep storm drains cleared so the rainfall can drain.



## SCW - Stage 2

## SPACE CITY WEATHER FLOOD SCALE Expected impact Historic examples

Stage

**Nuisance street flooding,** frontage road flooding, some minor impacts in a few locations

- Jan 2017 street flooding
- May 2018 flooding in Harris, southern Montgomery counties

Stage 2

**Flash flooding** with mostly localized impacts (i.e., just Sugar Land, or Katy, or The Woodlands)

- 2015 Halloween floods
- May 2019 floods in Sugar Land and Kingwood

Stage 3

**Significant flash flooding**; 100s of homes flooded; high impact timing (rush hour) or longer-duration flooding (Brazos, San Jacinto)

- 2016 Memorial Weekend floods
- 2009 April W. Houston flooding
  T.S. Imelda (Houston)

Stage **4** 

**Significant urban and suburban flooding** with widespread effects; thousands of homes flooded, may shut down city for day

- 2015 Memorial Day floods
- 2016 Tax Day floods
- 1994 mid-October floods

Stage 5

Major urban and suburban flooding; tens to hundreds of thousands of homes flooded, likely shuts down city for multiple days

- Hurricane Harvey
- T. S. Allison
- T. S. Imelda (Beaumont)

**Note:** This scale seeks to generalize regional effects. If you did not flood during a previous Stage 4 or 5 event, you may still flood in future Stage 4 or 5 events, or even lesser ones.

- The coast has largely been spared heavy rainfall for the last two days.
- On Wednesday and Thursday, the axis of strongest storms will shift to the Gulf Coast, raising the threat of widespread street flooding.
- SCW calling for a Stage 2 flood for now through Thursday evening.




