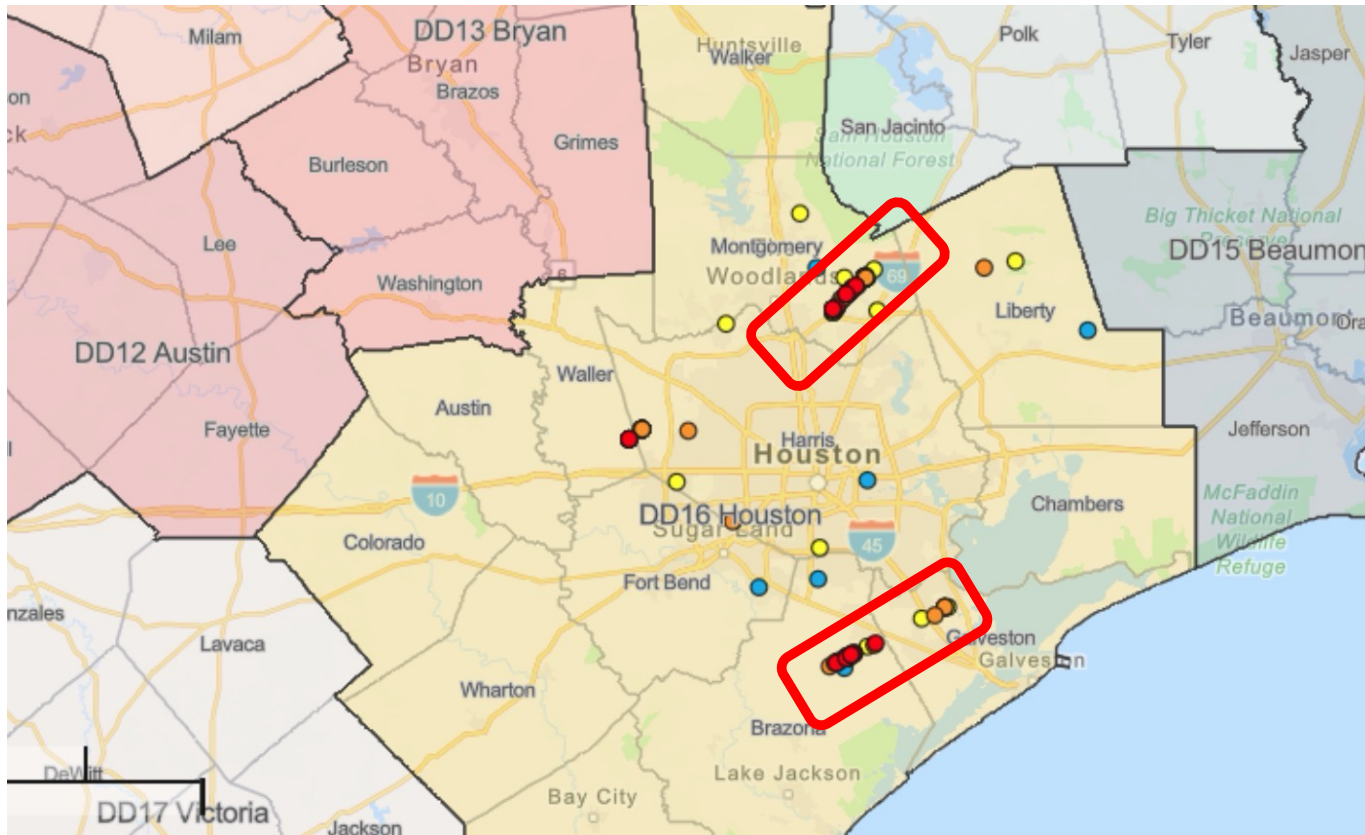

# Safety - Structural Integrity

large cracks in walls or foundations  
Sagging roofs  
uneven floors  
leaning walls  
visible damage to support beams  
missing shingles, damaged flashing, broken rafters  
water stains on ceilings  
signs of shifting or settling (windows, doors)

if you see any of these, consult a professional engineer or building inspector for a thorough evaluation.
