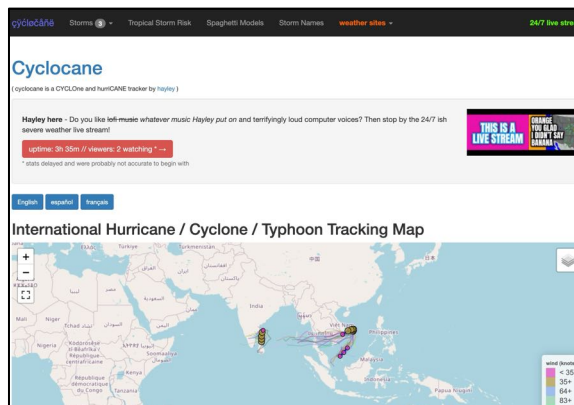

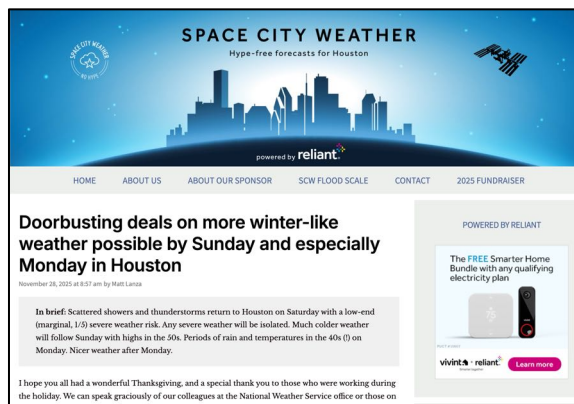

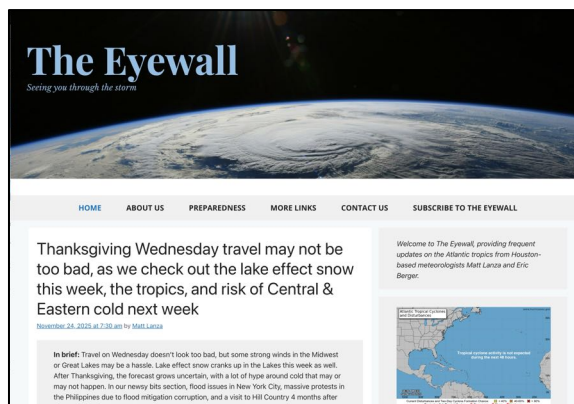

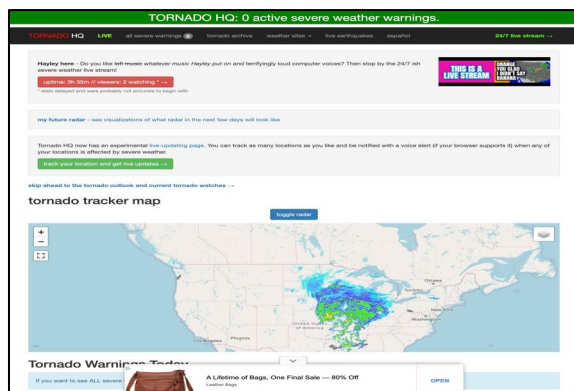

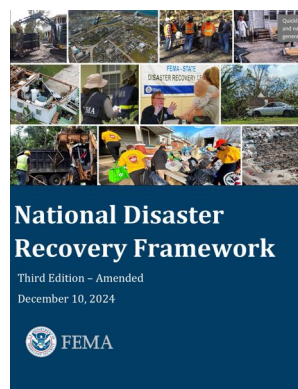

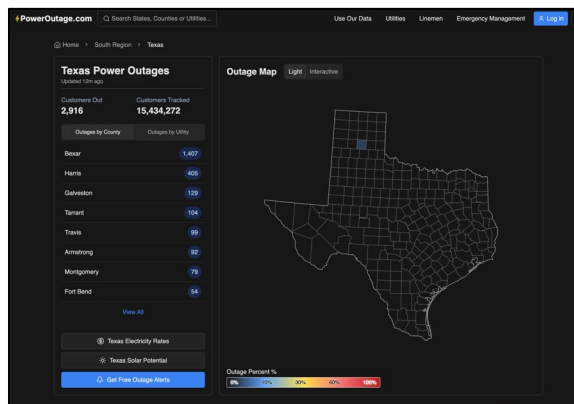

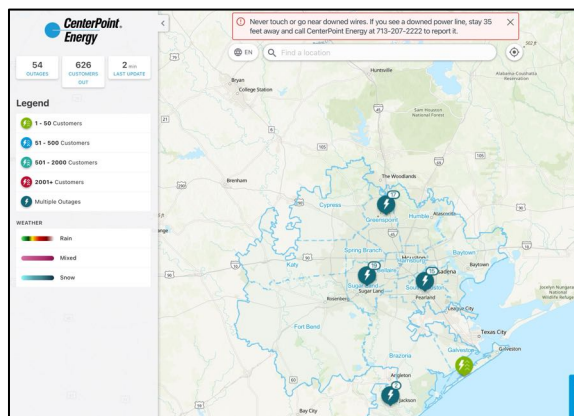

Power outages by county for Texas



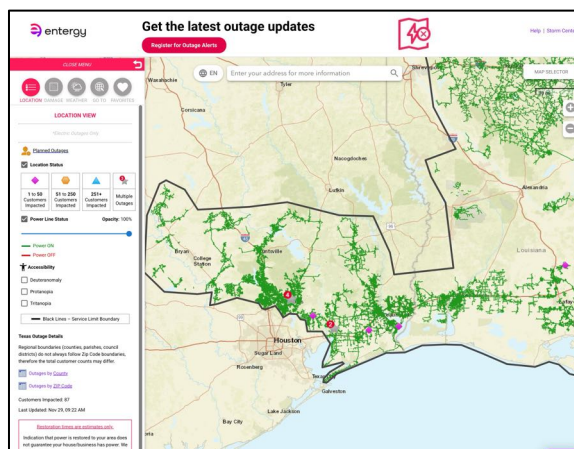

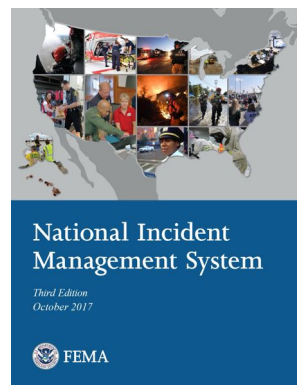
The NRI provides a nationwide assessment of community risk by combining hazard likelihood, potential impacts, and social vulnerability to show where disasters could cause the most damage.
