ALERT LEVEL 1 – ACTIVATED
Recovery Operations Beginning in
Harris, Liberty, Montgomery, and Walker Counties



TGCRVOAD, 5 May 2024. The TGCRVOAD has raised its alert level to ALERT LEVEL 1 – ACTIVATED as recovery operations begin in Harris, Liberty, Montgomery, and Walker Counties.

Situation

The flood waters in the San Jacinto River watershed have begun to recede, and recovery operations are now underway. The recovery effort will be staggered, first in areas where waters have safely receded and then in areas where we do not expect to obtain access for days or weeks.

Preliminary Course of Action

Our preliminary plan of action will involve the following steps:

- We will use Crisis Cleanup as our work order management tool.
- We will build situational awareness of the recovery work within the TGCRVOAD and our partners by encouraging those affected by the flood to complete the TDEM iStat and Connective surveys. We will share information about unmet needs in our Recovery Coordination Calls.
- We will collaborate using our resources to ensure no individual, family, or community is left behind. We will work together to redirect resources to underserved communities.
- We will ensure a smooth and efficient handoff to the Long-term Recovery Committees.

Recovery Coordination Conference Call

We have scheduled a series of Recovery Coordination Conference Calls for 9:00 AM this week, beginning tomorrow, May 6, 2024. The calls will be no longer than 50 minutes, preferably shorter.
